



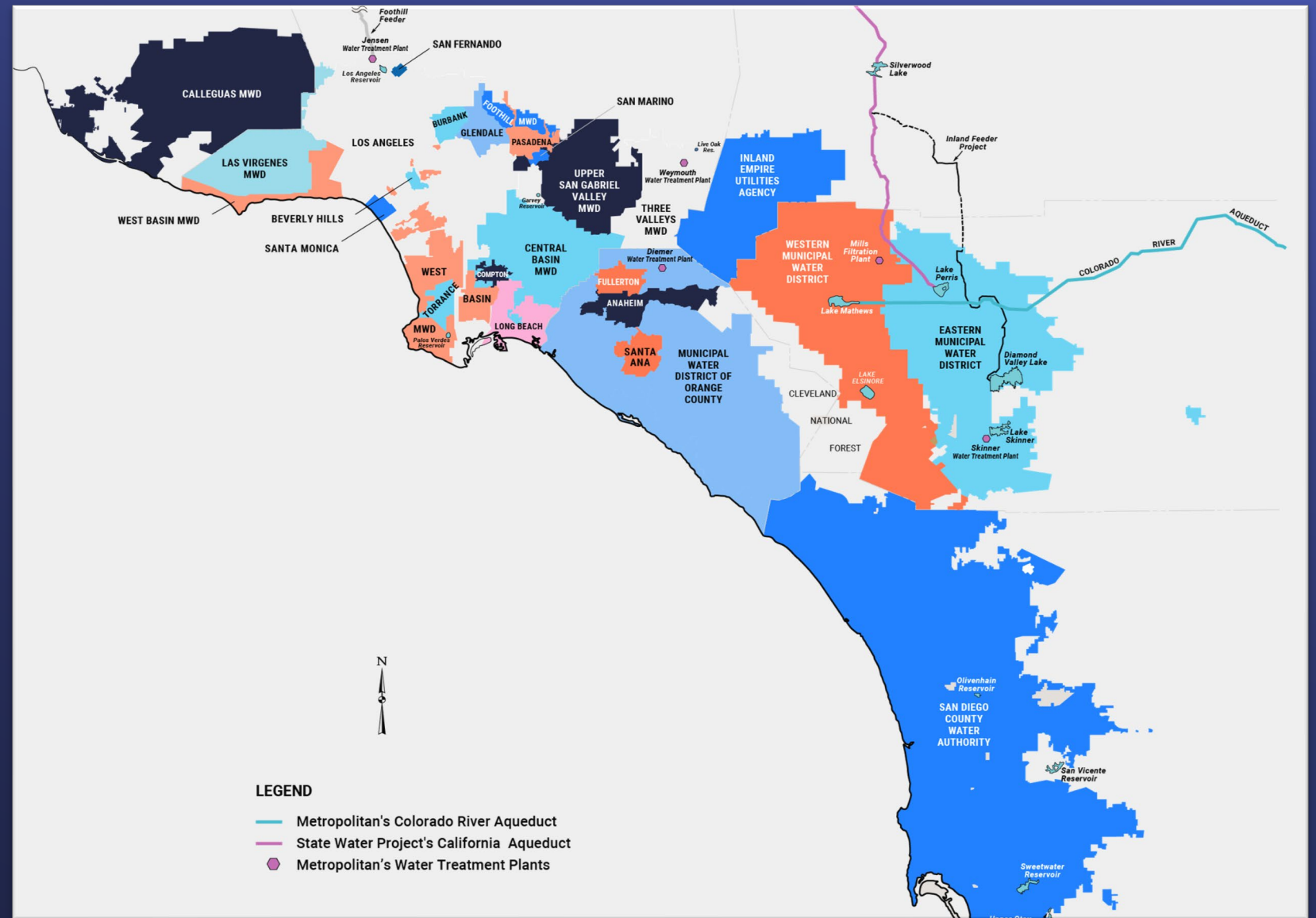

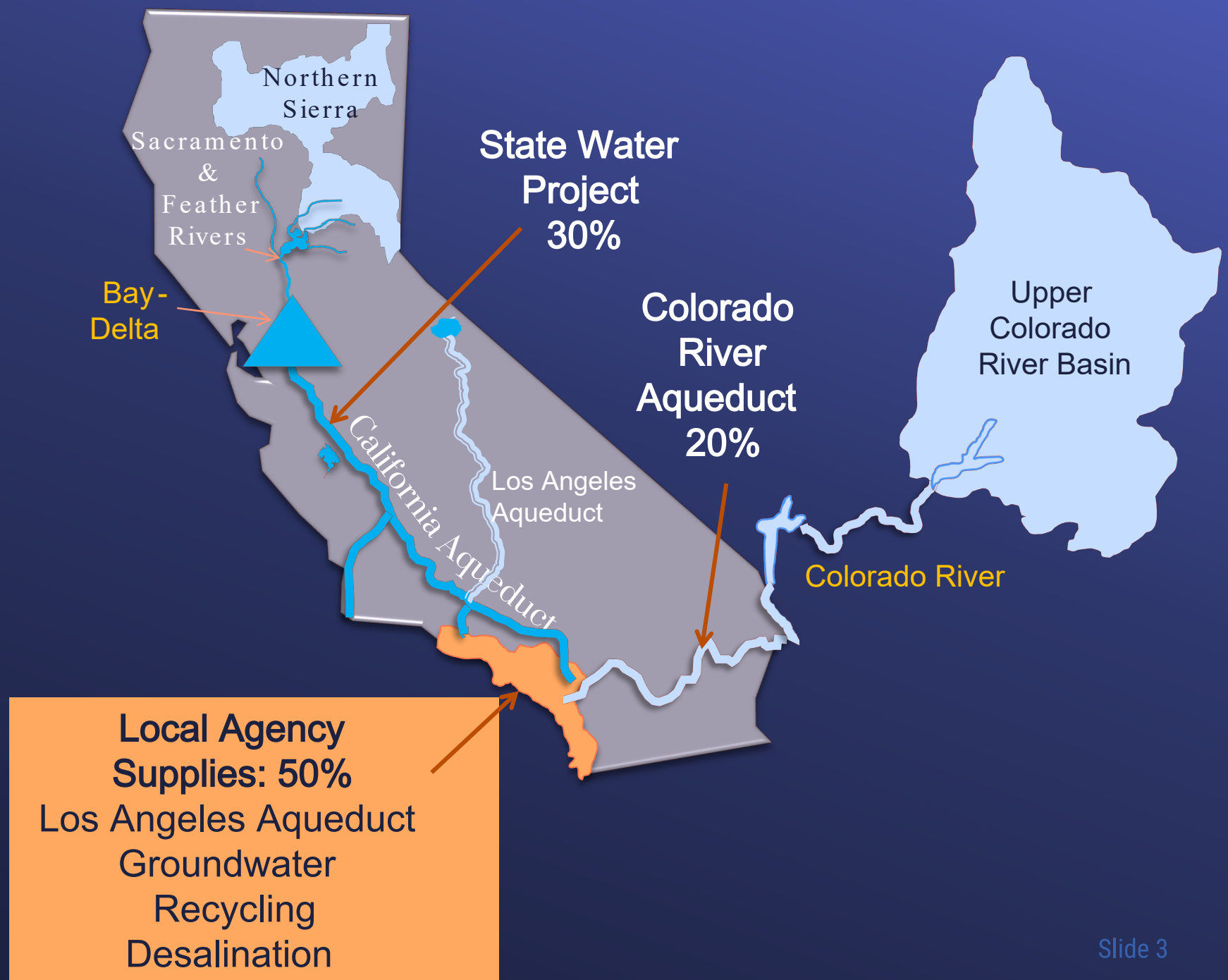

Water Supply*

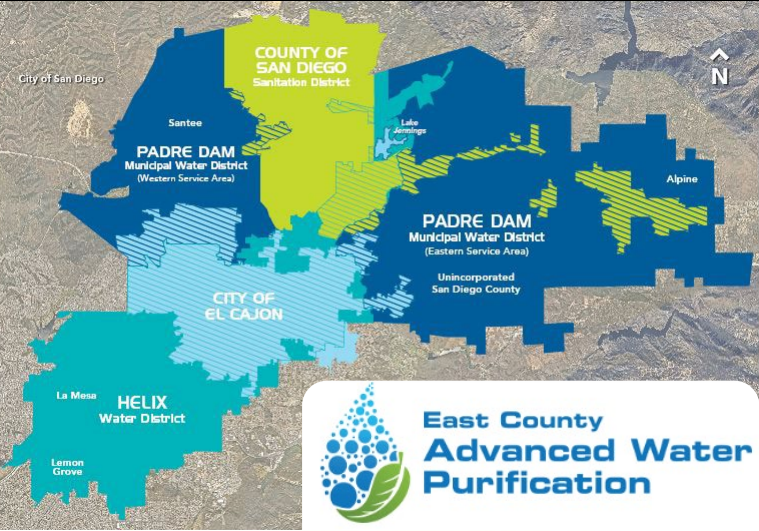

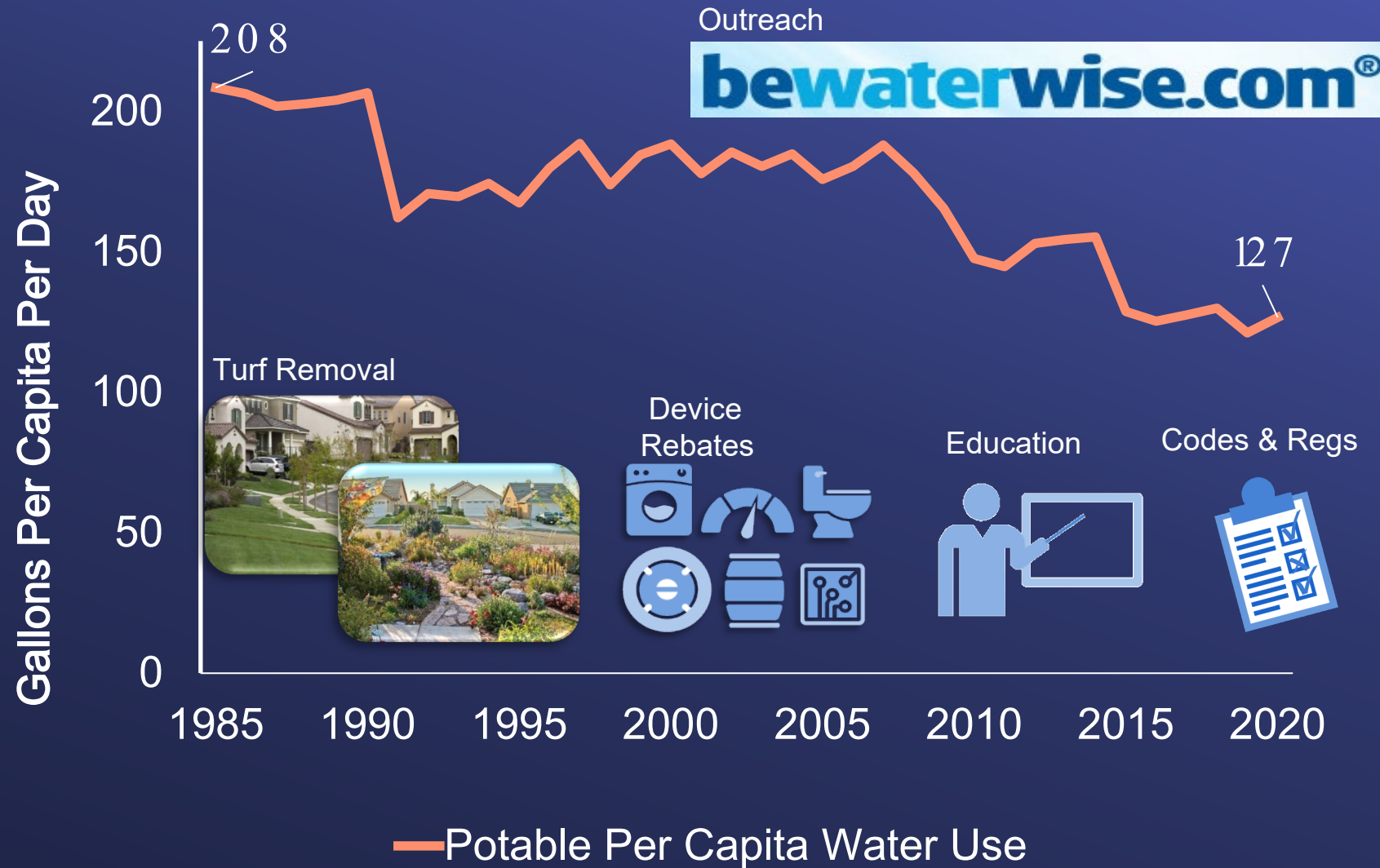

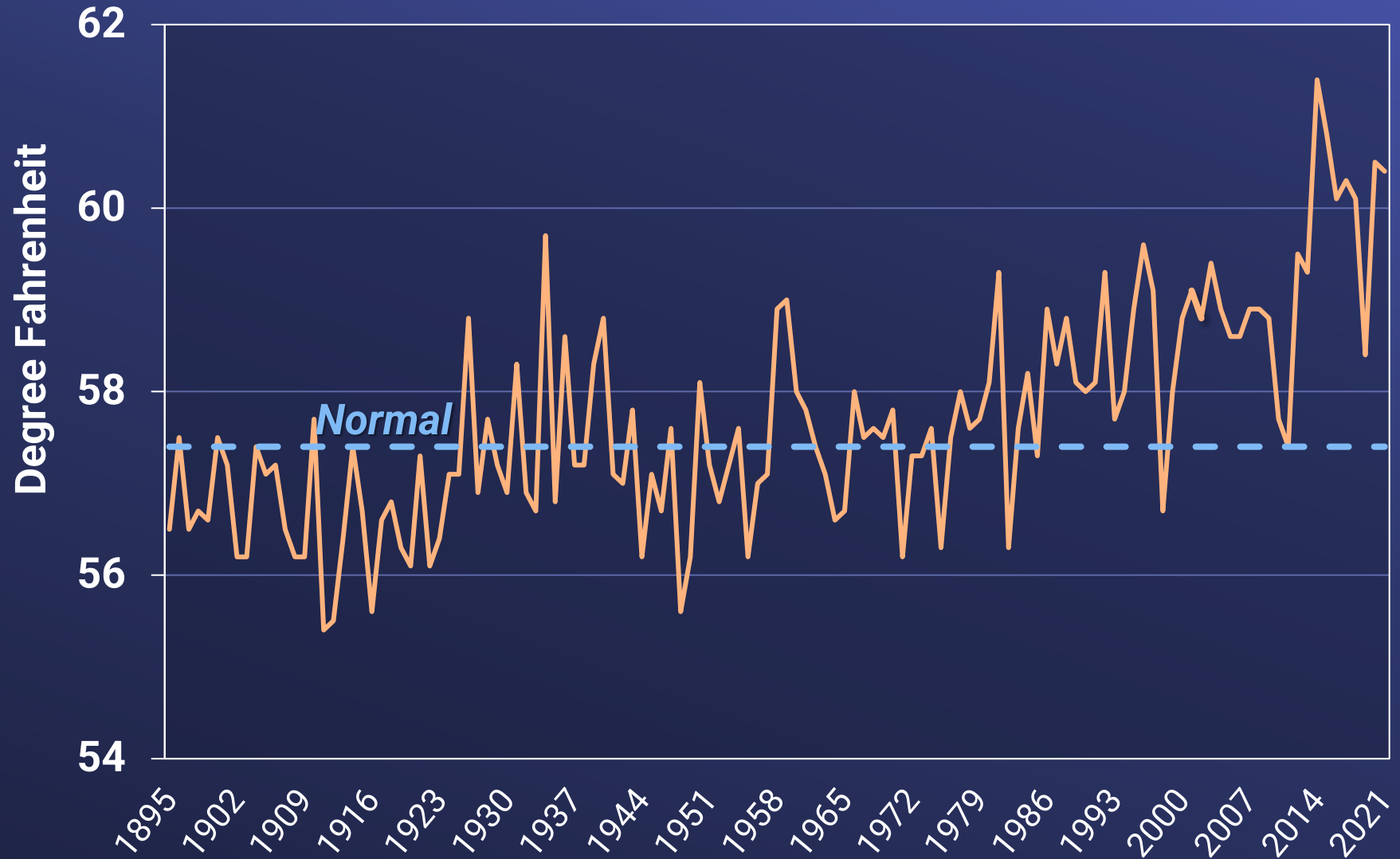

Warming trend since the turn of the century

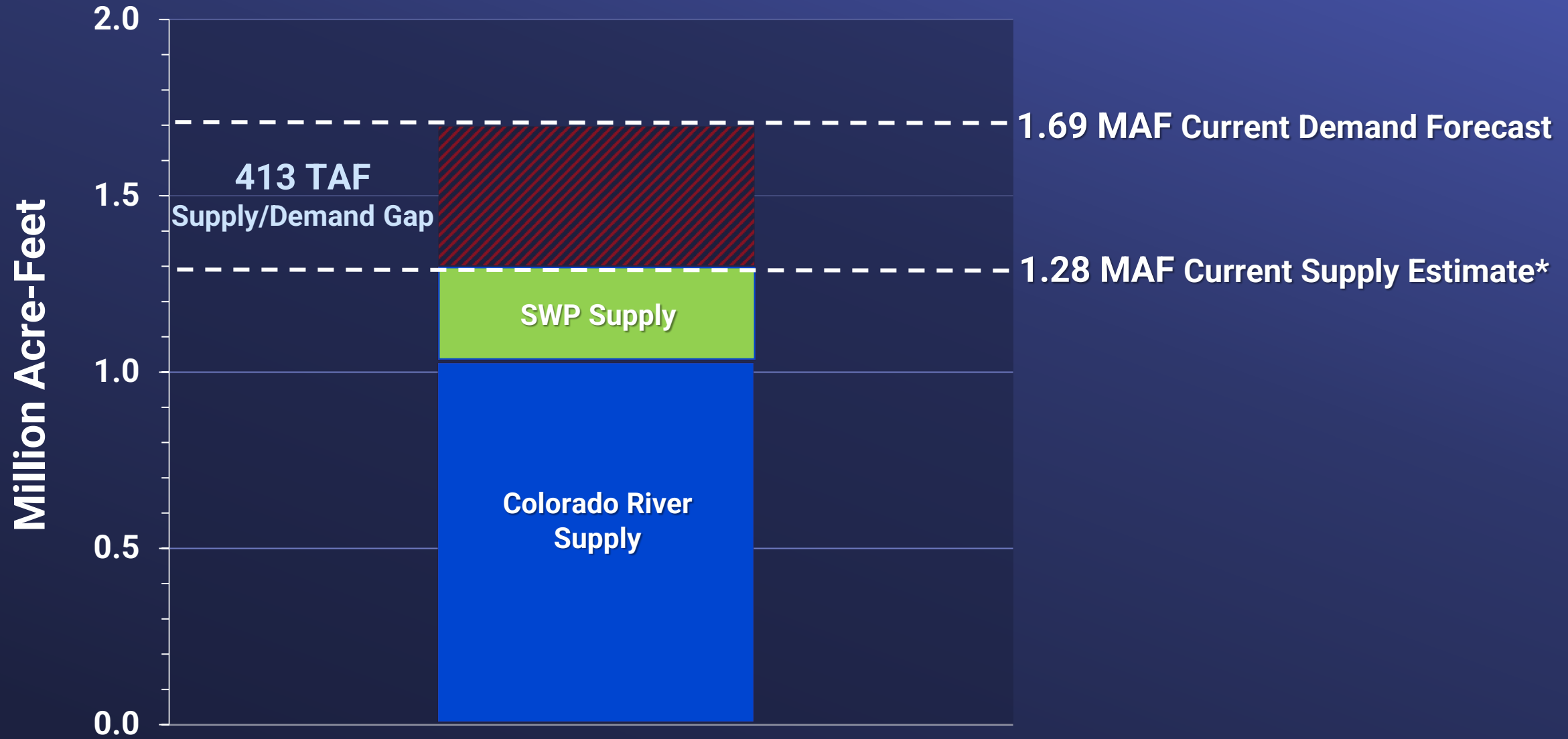
California Average Temperature



June 14, 2022: Commissioner Touton Calls for 2 – 4 MAF of Water Reductions in 2023

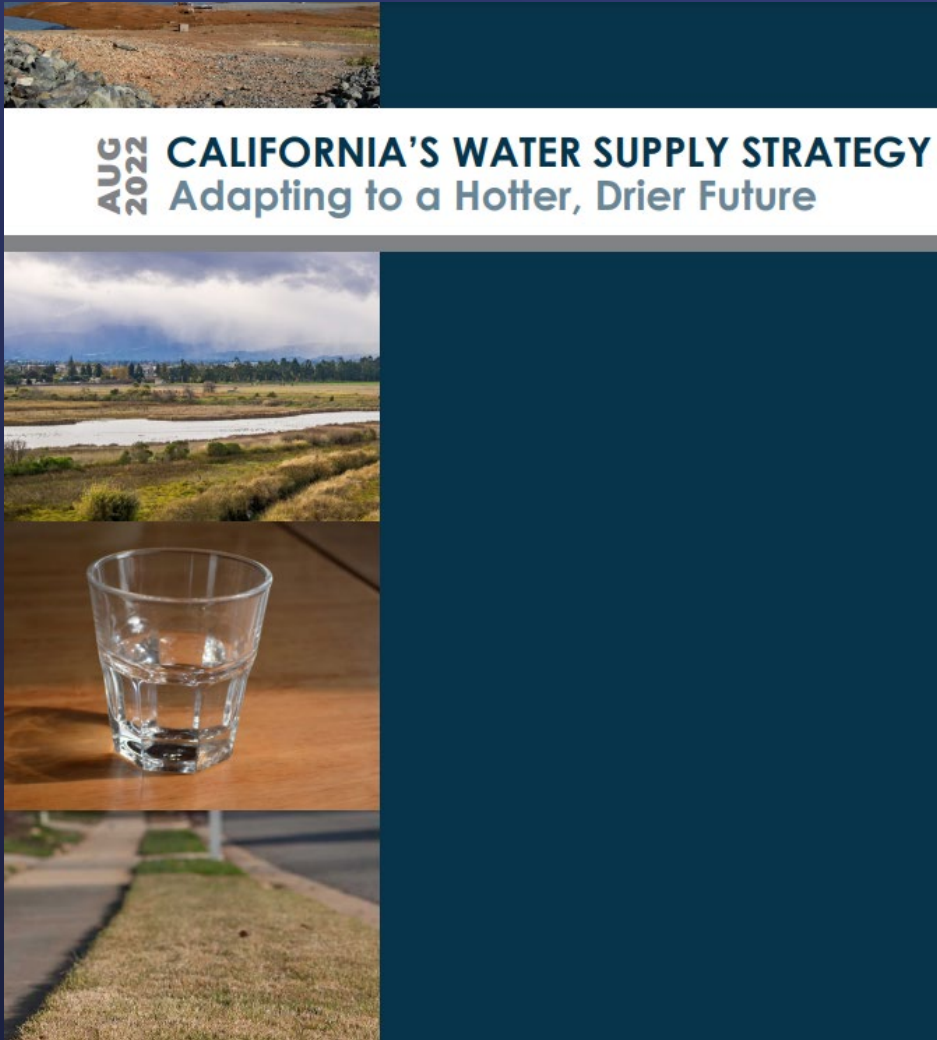


2022 Supply Demand Balance - MWD Regional Outlook



**SWP Supply includes 134 TAF of Human Health and Safety supplies. Colorado River Supply reflects higher priority water use adjustment*

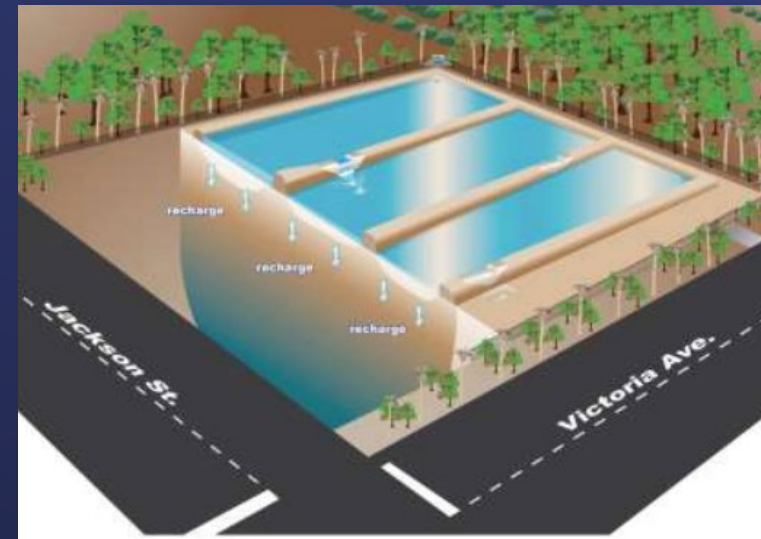
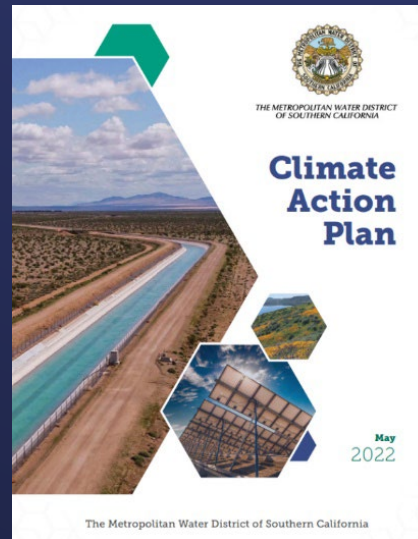
