This month, our meeting will take place at the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy (Conservancy) Board Room, 1450 Halyard Way, Suite 6, West Sacramento, California. We are excited to use the Conservancy's recently remodeled Board Room. Please note that we will be starting at 10:00 AM and that Meeting Services staff will be in contact regarding lunch options.

Special Assistant for Planning and Science Amanda Bohl will provide a report on the discussion and action outcomes from the recent Delta Plan Implementation Interagency Committee (DPIIC) meeting that occurred on November 4.

The Council will hear from the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy and Delta Protection Commission (Commission), as they provide an update on their activities. These activities include the Conservancy's current development of the grant guidelines for the Proposition 68 funded Community and Economic Enhancement Grant Program, and the Commission's update of the Agricultural Chapter of the Economic Sustainability Plan.

The Department of Water Resources, Central Valley Flood Protection Board, and Council staff will describe their role with Delta levees and the Memorandum of Understanding, an agreement that coordinates implementation of the Delta Levees Investment Strategy. The Department of Water Resources will also provide a report summarizing Delta levee expenditures.
