As we wrap up a productive year for the Council, our last meeting of 2019 will take place at Park Tower, 980 9th Street, 2nd Floor, Sacramento, California. The end of the year is a great time to look back and review what the Delta Plan's performance measures can tell us about the Delta. At the meeting, Deputy Executive Officer for Planning Jeff Henderson and Program Manager II Martina Koller will provide a year-in-review of the Delta Plan's performance measures and use of the performance measure dashboard. This information provides key insights into the state of the Delta based on Delta Plan metrics. To complement this information, Caitlin Sweeney, Director for the San Francisco Estuary Partnership and Dr. Letitia Grenier, Resilient Landscapes Program Director for the San Francisco Estuary Report, which assesses indicators of estuary health across the Bay and Delta.

Lastly, staff from the Department of Water Resources Delta Conveyance Program will provide the Council with an update on the schedule for the release of environmental documents (i.e., Notice of Preparation) relating to water conveyance infrastructure in the Delta.
