informs Council decision-making and tribal engagement. The listening session starts at 2 pm, and the Delta Independent Science Board Chair and other Delta agency representatives may join at the dais for this portion of the meeting.

The Department of Water Resources will present updates on the Delta Conveyance Project and provide an overview of the public comments received on the Draft Environmental Impact Report.

We also have two exciting introductions at this month's meeting. Newly named Delta Watermaster Jay Ziegler will present to the Council for the first time since being appointed in March. Dr. Lisa Wainger will give her first Delta Independent Science Board update since becoming Chair in September 2022. We will also hear updates from Campbell Ingram, executive officer of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy, and Bruce Blodgett, the executive director of the Delta Protection Commission, on their respective agency's activities.
