Mission: Working collaboratively and in coordination with local communities, the Conservancy leads efforts to protect, enhance, and restore the Delta's economy, agriculture and working landscapes, and environment for the benefit of the Delta region, its local communities, and the citizens of California.





Our Role

- Act as a primary state agency to implement ecosystem restoration in the Delta and Suisun Marsh, and
- Support efforts that advance environmental protection and the economic well-being of Delta residents



Grant Programs

- Proposition 1 \$50 million funding 35 locally supported projects, affecting over 8,000 acres wetland, floodplain and water quality
- Proposition 68 and Climate, Access and Restoration funds \$23 million funding 11 projects – park construction/improvements, trail systems, historic preservation and welcome centers
- Delta Drought Response \$22 million funding 97 grants to farmers to reduce water use to improve Delta water quality and support migratory birds during drought – 30,000 acres enrolled
- Nature Based Solutions \$36 million to support subsidence and carbon emission reduction
