Meeting Summary March 7, 2024



DELTA STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL

The Delta Stewardship Council (Council) established the Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee (DPIIC) after adopting the Delta Plan in 2013 and continues to oversee DPIIC activities as required by the Delta Reform Act. The Restoration Subcommittee (Subcommittee) was formed by the 2022 amendment to Chapter Four of the Delta Plan which recommended the formation of a restoration subcommittee to address barriers to restoration in the Delta. Staffed by the Council and Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy (Delta Conservancy), Subcommittee members collaborate to support a vision of the Delta that is a mosaic of natural and human communities, is resilient to stressors, adaptable, and accessible for the public.

Opening and Introductions

Jeff Henderson: The Delta Stewardship Council has posted an update to its performance measures for the 2022 Delta Plan amendment.

Amanda Bohl, Delta Stewardship Council: The Delta Agency Science Working Group will meet on March 19. The full DPIIC will meet April 15.

Campbell Ingram: The Delta Conservancy has provided Nature Based Solutions funding to 4 projects, which will rewet 11,0000 acres of habitat and result in 110,000 tons per year avoided carbon emissions. An agreement for Webb Tract has been signed.

Amanda Cranford: NOAA has released its five-year status review for winter-run chinook salmon.

Impacts, Risks, and Management of Invasive Aquatic Vegetation in Tidal Wetland Restoration Projects (Information Item)

Dr. Chapple introduced panelists Gina Darin, Environmental Program Manager at the Department of Water Resources (DWR); Dr. Louise Conrad, Lead Scientist at DWR; and Jeffrey Caudill, Senior Environmental Scientist at the Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways. The panelists presented and discussed successes, challenges, and adaptive management needs related to the control of invasive aquatic vegetation in the Delta.

Following the presentation and Subcommittee discussion, Dr. Chapple asked for public comments. There was one public comment from Doug Johnson of the California Invasive Plant Council.
