


Temperature-dependent Chinook salmon smolt predation hazard

Inverse relationship between flow and temperature during April-June.

Observations show a slight increase in Chinook salmon smolt predation by Largemouth Bass with temperature, but not by Striped Bass. Widespread mortality of smolt at temperatures of 68°F was instead attributed to a decline in smolt swimming speed with temperature.



