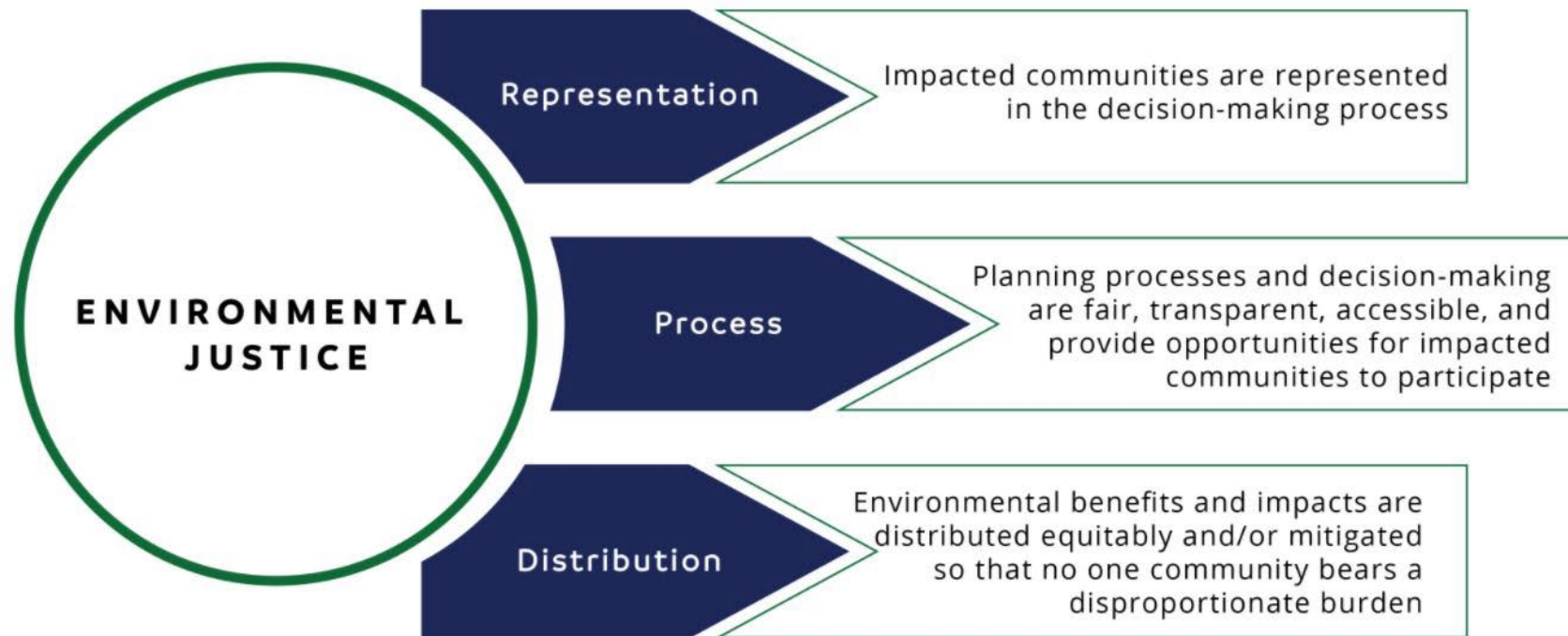

# Environmental Justice (EJ)

- The fair treatment of people of all races, cultures, and incomes with respect to the development, adoption, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies. (Gov. Code, § 65040.12, subd. (e)).



# Purpose

- The Council's 2019 **Five-Year Review** of the Delta Plan:
- Identified EJ as a key emerging issue.
- Recommended that staff **prepare an issue paper** "to investigate the potential need for additional strategies or responses within the Delta Plan to address disadvantaged communities and EJ."

# Objectives



**Build a network** of community leaders and organizations to inform and support the Council's EJ work;



**Identify environmental justice issues** within the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, the Delta watershed, and areas that use Delta water; and



**Identify options** to address those issues.

- Began drafting an EJ history for the Delta
- Conducted literature review

## WINTER/SPRING 2022

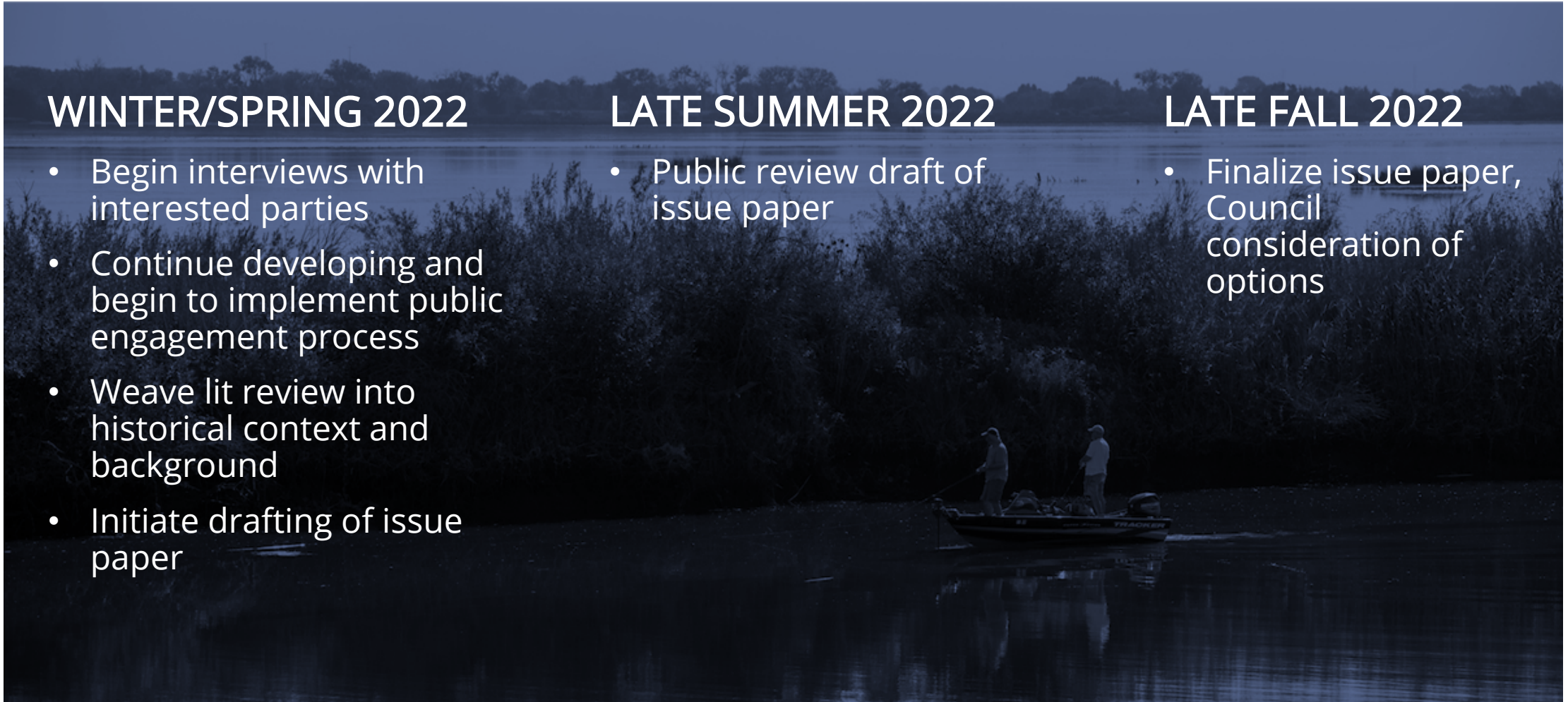
- Begin interviews with interested parties
