Brief Summary: The Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Reform Act of 2009 provides that it is the intent of the Legislature to provide for the sustainable management of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta ecosystem, to provide for a more reliable water supply for the state, to protect and enhance the quality of water supply from the Delta, as defined, and to establish a governance structure that will direct efforts across state agencies to develop a legally enforceable Delta Plan. This bill would make the provisions of the Delta Plan severable.

State Budget Update

- Governor Newsom signed the 2025 Budget Act in late June, addressing an \$11.8 billion General Fund deficit for 2025-26
- Also signed into law AB 130 and SB 131 relating to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), taking effect immediately
- Allocations for Proposition 4 are forthcoming
- Does not currently reflect impact of cuts in federal spending in the One Big Beautiful Bill Act

Federal Budget Update

- One Big Beautiful Bill Act signed into law on July 4th
- Tracking direct budget requests from federal agencies of interest
 - National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), United States Geologic Survey (USGS), U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (USBR), U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Army Corps), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and more
- Tracking House and Senate Appropriations Committee bills
 - Subcommittees on Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies; Energy and Water Development; Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies
- Environmental Protection Agency to close Office of Research and Development
- We will provide updates going forward
